Weather Advisory No. 01 for Low Pressure Area (LPA) AND Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ)

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- At 08:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) embedded in the ITCZ was estimated based on all available data at 315 KM East of Surigao City (9.8°N, 128.4°E) the combined effect of LPA and ITCZ will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over the regions of CARAGA, Northern Mindanao, Zamboanga Peninsula, and the Provinces of Southern Leyte, Bohol, Siquijor, Southern Cebu, Southern Negros Oriental, Southern Negros Occidental, and Lanao Del Sur. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.
- Meanwhile light to moderate rains and thunderstorms will prevail over the rest of Visayas and of Mindanao.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. **01** for Low Pressure Area (LPA) to all OCD Regional Offices VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, XIII (CARAGA), Negros Island Region (NIR), and Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM) through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- The public and DRRM Councils concerned are advised to continuously monitor the updates which will be issued on or before the public weather forecast at 5:00 PM today. The next weather advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow
