SITUATION OVERVIEW:

 At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 30 km east Northeast of Iloilo City, Iloilo (10.8 °N, 122.8 °E). This weather system will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over Visayas, the Regions of Bicol, CARAGA, Zamboanga Peninsula, and the Province of Palawan. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 02 for Low Pressure Area (LPA) to all OCD Regional Offices MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX and XIII (CARAGA) through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- The public and DRRM Councils concerned are advised to continuously monitor the updates which will be issued on or before the public weather forecast at 5:00 PM today. The next weather advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.
