I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **370 km west northwest of Iba, Zambales (16.6 °N, 116.8 °E)**. This weather system will **bring cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms over the provinces of Bataan, Zambales and Mindoro**. Also, the LPA is expected to develop into a tropical depression with 12-24 hours outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

In this development this is the final weather advisory.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. **04** for Low Pressure Area (LPA) to all OCD Regional Offices III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, and NCR through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- The public and DRRM Councils concerned are advised to continuously monitor the updates which will be issued on or before the public weather forecast at 5:00 PM today. The next weather advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.
