I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 250 km West of Ambulong, Batangas (13.7 °N, 118.8 °E). This weather system will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over Bicol Region and the Provinces of Cavite, Batangas, Mindoro, Quezon, Aurora, and Northern Palawan. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.

Meanwhile, Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon will have cloudy skieswith light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 03 for Low Pressure Area (LPA) to all OCD Regional Offices III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, and NCR through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
