Flooding in Matalam, Cotabato Province (Region XII) 1.

A. Situation Overview:

- · At about 06:00 PM on 06 June 2017, three (3) barangays in the Municipality of Matalam were flooded due to heavy rainfall in the area which started at 3:00PM brought about by the Inter Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Mindanao.
- · As of 4:30 PM, 07 June 2017, the affected areas were still submerged to flood waters which resulted to damaged properties and crops especially rice fields.

B. Effects:

A total of <u>265 families / 1,274 persons were affected</u> in four (4) barangays:

C. Actions Taken:

- OCD XII is continuously monitoring the situation .
- · MDRRMO Matalam is closely monitoring the situation and alerted all BDRRMCs regarding the flooding and possible pre-emptive evacuation.
- MDRRMO validated the affected areas and families.
- Local SaR group and BDRRMCs are on standby status.
- LGU Matalam distributed family food packs assistance to affected families.
- Municipal Agriculturist Office of Matalam is still validating the extent of damage in • agriculture (rice fields).

II. Flooding in Maguindanao (ARMM)

A. Situation Overview:

- Since 04 May 2017, the Province of Maguindanao has experienced light to moderate rains due to local thunderstorms and weather systems affecting the region.
- This has caused overflowing in the tributaries of Mindanao River Basin particularly Pulangi River, Mindanao River and Ligawasan Marsh which resulted major flooding in seventeen (17) municipalities.

B. Effects:

Affected Population

 As of 3:00 PM, 08 June 2017, a total of <u>45,495 families/ 227,475 persons</u> were affected in seventeen (17) municipalities in Maguindanao:

D. Actions Taken

OCD-ARMM

- Continuous coordination with Local DRRM Officials and PAGASA Station Cotabato re weather updates
- Closely monitoring the situation.

PDRRMC Maguindanao

 Augmented 1,500 food packs (5 kilos rice, noodles, coffee, can goods and sugar) to affected families in Kabuntalan.

- MSWDOs concerned are coordinating the logistical requirements to facilitate the relief assistance coming from DSWD-RFU12 intended for the affected families in Maguindanao
- Coordination with DSWD-Maguindanao on the assessment and validation on the numbers of affected families/individuals
- MSWDOs and MDRRMOs concerned are still continuing to assess as well as validate the number of affected families and their needs.

MDRRMC-Pagalungan

 The MDRRMC-Pagalungan is conducting validation and assessment of affected families.

MDRRMO-Datu Piang

 Reported a clearing operation of water hyacinth accumulation at Engr. Wahid Piang Bridge (Connecting Midsayap and Datu Piang). The operation is headed by DPWH-ARMM and the MDRRMC-Datu Piang provided 50 volunteers.
