#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

The Low Pressure Area (LPA) over the Pacific Ocean has entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

At 02:00 AM today, it was estimated based on all available data at **1,010 km east northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (14.0°N, 134.5 °E)**. The trough of this weather system will bring cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms over Eastern Visayas.

The **LPA** is expected to develop into a **Tropical Depression** within the next **24 to 36 hours**.

#### **II. ACTIONS TAKEN**

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. **01** for Low Pressure Area (LPA) to all OCD Regional Offices III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, and NCR through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- The public and DRRM Councils concerned are advised to continuously monitor the updates which will be issued on or before the public weather forecast at 5:00 PM today. The next weather advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.
