I. Initial Report re Fire Incident at Temporary Housing, Aroma, Road 10, Vitas, Manila (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

- At around around 1510H 18 August 2017, a fire incident transpired at brgy. 105 Zone 8 District 1 involving residential light materials.
- The said incident reached Task Force Alpha at 1644H 18 August 2017 and was declared fire out at 2026H 18 August 2017.
- The cause of this incident is still under investigation.

B. Effects:

- A total of 500 families were displaced and currently accommodated at Tondo Basketball Court.
- Six (6) buildings were reported affected.
- The estimated cost of damage is more or less ₱3,000,000.00.

C. Actions Taken:

- Manila DRRMO Command Center dispatches Rescue Team to respond to the said area.
- OCD NCR is closely monitoring the said incident.

II. Initial Report re Fire Incident at Camia Street, Malate, Manila (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 1550H 18 August 2017 a fire incident transpired at Brgy. 704 Zone 77 District 5 involving residential light materials.
- The said incident reached Task Force Alpha at around 1705H and was declared Fire Out at 1920H.
- The cause of the said incident is under investigation.

D. Effects:

- A total of 250 families were displaced and currently evacuated at Brgy. Amadome covered court.
- A total of 125 houses were reported affected.
- The estimated cost of damage is more or less ₱1,000,000.00.

E. Actions Taken:

- Manila DRRMO Command Center dispatches Rescue Team to respond to the said area.
- OCD NCR is closely monitoring the said incident.

III. Initial Report re Food Poisoning in Sta. Lucia High School, Brgy. Sta. Lucia, Quezon City (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 1300H 18 August 2017, a wave of students were brought to the school clinic manifesting various symptoms related to food poisoning such as dizziness, stomach ache, vomiting, chills, cold sweat and difficulty in breathing.
- As per the initial investigation of the Head Teacher in TLE, it turned out that the students consumed beverages with a “chemical like” smell wherein the water used in these beverages came from a faucet with a brand new hose was attached.

B. Effects:

- A partial total of 177 individuals were affected which is brought to various hospitals as follows:

C. Actions Taken:

- EMS Coordinator of Quezon City Health Department with members of QCRRMO EMS Team assessed and treated students with minor symptoms while QCRRM SAR, Brgy. Sta Lucia BPSO and UNTV Rescue transported students experiencing more critical symptoms.
- City Councilor assisted in coordination and transportation of victims to various Government and Private Hospitals.
- OCD NCR is continuously monitoring the incident through Quezon City DRRM Office.
