I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Area of Responsibility (PAR).

Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy rains within the 400 km diameter of the Severe Tropical Storm.

This weather system will continue to enhance the Southwest Monsoon that will bring light up to heavy rains over Luzon and Western Visayas particularly the provinces of Pangasinan, Zambales, Bataan, Cavite, Batangas and Mindoro. Sea travel is risky over the western seaboard of Northern Luzon. All Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals are now lifted.

"ISANG" was estimated based on all available data at 395 km West of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) (20.5 °N, 118.2 °E)
Maximum sustained winds of 110 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 137 kph
Forecast to move West Northwest at 25 kph
 24 Hour(Tomorrow afternoon): 980 km West Northwest of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)(22.0°N, 112.7°E) 48 Hour(Thursday afternoon):1,550 km West Northwest of
Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)(23.8°N, 107.4°E)

With this development and unless re-entry occurs, this is the final warning for this weather disturbance.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 14 for Severe Weather Bulletin No. 14 (Final) "ISANG" to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
