PRESENT WEATHER:

As of 4:40 AM, the water level of Montalban has reach 24.90 m reach critical level (24.2 m) and Burgos has reach 28.63 m reach critical level (28.4 m) may be expected to rise due to monsoon rains. The low-lying areas along the Marikina River from Nangka, San Mateo, Tumana, Sto. Nino and Marcos Highway. All residents living in the aforementioned areas, especially those near the river banks are advised to be alert possible river flooding.

PAGASA shall continue to monitor the hydrological condition of Pasig-Marikina River.

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are still advised to take necessary precautionary measures.
