 On 23 August 2017, an earthquake was felt in Albuera, Leyte with the following details:

A. DAMAGES

D. DAMAGED HOUSES

a. A total of seventeen (17) houses were partially damaged in the Albuera (15) and Ormoc City (2) due to the earthquake

III. ACTIONS TAKEN

A. NATIONAL

NDRRM Operations Center

a. Immediately disseminated the earthquake information to OCDROs VII and VIII, and other concerned stakeholders through facsimile, SMS, website, and twitter account for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs. Moreover, advised them to undertake precautionary measures and to monitor the situation for any possible effects of said earthquake particularly in areas with reported intensities.

DOST-PHIVOLCS

a. Sent Earthquake Information No. 01, 02 and 03, and is closely monitoring the situation. Any new significant development will be immediately relayed to all concerned.

DSWD

a. Continuously coordinating with DSWD-FO VII for significant reports on assistance and relief efforts

B. REGIONAL

- a. Continuously monitoring the incident. No damages reported and monitored.
- b. Coordinated with the affected LGUs regarding the effects of the earthquake.

DSWD VIII

- a. In close coordination with Ormoc City and Albuera
- b. Relief assistance are readily available and can immediately be provided once requested.

DPWH

a. Conducted assessment of roads and bridges.

b. Ongoing assessment of school buildings.

PDRRMC Leyte

a. Close monitoring of the incident, and coordinated with concerned Local Government Units (LGUs) in the Province of Leyte.

CDRRMC-Ormoc City

- a. Conducted Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (DRRMC) meeting.
- b. Deployed teams to conduct Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis.
- c. Conducted debriefing to students.

MDRRMC-Albuera, Leyte

a. Conducted assessment of damages in the municipality.

MDRRMC-Kananga, Leyte

a. Closely monitoring the incident.
