I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM, 29 August 2017, the **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated based on all available data at **730km East Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes (17.0°N, 130.0°E)**. The weather system currently will bring light to moderate rains and occasional heavy rains associated with isolated thunderstorms over the Cagayan Valley region and the eastern sections of Central and Southern Luzon. It is **expected to develop into a Tropical Depression** within the next **24 to 36 hours**.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
