I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated, based on all available data, at **205km West Northwest of Calayan Is., Cagayan (19.8N, 119.6E)**. This weather system will continue to enhance the Southwest Monsoon which will bring light to moderate rains and occasional heavy rains due to isolated thunderstorms over western section of Luzon including Metro Manila. The LPA is **expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) tonight or early morning tomorrow**. It is still likely to develop into a Tropical Depression within the next 24 to 36 hours outside the PAR.

Meanwhile, Severe Tropical Storm "Sanvu" was estimated at 2,150 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (26.8N, 141.9E) (OUTSIDE PAR). The weather system is not expected to affect any part of the country.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 03 for Low Pressure Area** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- The public and DRRM Councils concerned are advised to continuously monitor the updates.
