I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM, **30 August 2017**, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **85km East of Aparri, Cagayan (18.5°N, 122.4°E)**. The weather system currently will bring **moderate and occasional heavy rains associated with isolated thunderstorms over Northern Luzon** which can trigger flashfloods and landslides. Light to moderate rains with possible heavy rains and lightning due to thunderstorm will affect the northern portions of Central Luzon today. The LPA will weaken while traversing Northern Luzon today but will re-emerge over the west coast of Luzon tomorrow morning. However, it is still likely to develop into a Tropical Depression within the next 36 hours.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 02 for Low Pressure Area** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- The public and DRRM Councils concerned are advised to continuously monitor the updates.
