I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 7:00 PM today, the Tropical Depression was estimated at 2,115 KM East of Southern Luzon (14.9⁰N, 143.2⁰E) (Outside PAR) with maximum sustained winds of 45 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 60 KM/H. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 25 KM/H.

This Tropical Cyclone is outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and has no direct effect in any part of the country as of this moment. However, it is expected to enter PAR on Monday and will be named "LANNIE".

The weather system is expected to move generally West-Northwestward towards the direction of extreme Northern Luzon-Taiwan area. Furthermore, the possibility of further intensification is highly likely.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Tropical Cyclone Advisory No. 01 for Tropical Depression (TD) outside PAR** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrant.
