



## NDRRMC UPDATE

### **Tropical Cyclone Advisory No. 02 for Tropical Storm 'Talim'**

#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Tropical Storm Talim was estimated at **1,745 KM** East of Southern Luzon (**16.1°N, 140.2°E**) (Outside PAR) with maximum sustained winds of **65 KM/H** near the center and gustiness of up to **80 KM/H**. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 25 KM/H.

This Tropical Cyclone is outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and has no direct effect in any part of the country as of this moment. However, it is expected to enter PAR **tomorrow morning** and will be named "LANNIE".

The weather system is expected to move generally West-Northwestward towards the direction of extreme Northern Luzon-Taiwan area. Furthermore, the possibility of further intensification is highly likely.

Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 570 km Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (14/2N, 129.8E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms over Visayas, Bicol Region, Northern Mindanao, CARAGA, and the Province of Palawan.

#### II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Tropical Cyclone Advisory No. 02 for Tropical Storm 'Talim'** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrant.
