I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Typhoon outside of Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated on all available data at 1,300 km East of Northern Luzon (17.9°N, 135.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 120 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 145 km/h. It is moving West Northwest at 25 km/h.

The weather system is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility early afternoon today then continue moving towards extreme Northern Luzon-Taiwan area. Likewise, it is expected to intensify further as it continues to move in the general direction of Extreme Northern Luzon-Taiwan area.

Meanwhile, the previously monitored the Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Bicol Region was estimated based on all available data at 400 km East of Quezon Province (14.8°N, 125.7°E). This weather system is expected to bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains over Visayas, Southern Luzon, Central Luzon, and Metro Manila beginning today and tomorrow. Flashfloods and landslides is expected over Bicol Region and the provinces of Zambales and Aurora.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Tropical Cyclone Advisory No. 03
 to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the
 NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs
 from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrant.
