## I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Tropical Depression "MARING" has accelerated and is about to make a landfall in the vicinity of Mauban, Quezon.

Moderate to heavy rains will be experienced over Bicol region, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, Metro Manila, Central Luzon, Pangasinan due to TD "MARING". Residents of these areas are alerted against possible landsides and flashfloods.

Sea travel is risky over the Eastern seaboards of Aurora, Quezon, and Bicol region.

Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal over Catanduanes is now lifted.

Location of eye/center	At 7:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "MARING" was estimated based on all available data at 35 km South of Infanta, Quezon (14.5°N, 121.8°E).
Strength	Maximum winds of up to 60 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 80 kph.
