I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 am today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **625 km east of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (8.4N,132.0E)**. This weather system will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms which may trigger flashfloods and landslides over the regions of CARAGA and Davao. Meanwhile, light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms is expected to prevail over eastern and central Visayas and the rest of Mindanao.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 01 for Low Pressure Area to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
