I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, The Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **240km East of Catarman, Northern Samar (12.1N, 126.8E)**. This weather system will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms which may trigger flashfloods and landslides over Samar provinces, Western Visayas and Northern Palawan. Meanwhile, light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms is expected to prevail over Bicol region, Mindanao and the rest of Visayas.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory **No. 02** for Low Pressure Area to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
