I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Low Pressure Area West of Northern Luzon has developed into a Tropical Depression and was named "NANDO"

Estimated rainfall amount is moderate to occasionally heavy rains within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.

Sea travel is risky over the western seaboard of Northern and Central Luzon. Expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) tonight or tomorrow early morning.

Location of eye/center	At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "NANDO" was estimated based on all available data at 310 km West Northwest of Dagupan City, Pangasinan (16.6°N, 117.5°E).
Strength	Maximum winds of up to 45 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 60 kph.
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move West Northwest at 24 kph
Forecast Positions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 hour (Tomorrow afternoon): 810 km West Northwest of Sinait, Ilocos Sur (OUTSIDE PAR) (19.4°N, 113.0°E) • 48 hour (Monday afternoon): 1,285 km West Northwest of Laoag City, Ilocos Norte (OUTSIDE PAR) (22.0°N, 109.0°E)

ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Advisory No. 01 for Tropical Depression "NANDO" to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded in the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants
- The public and DRRM Councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions and watch for the next weather bulletin to be issued at 11 PM today
