I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TROPICAL DEPRESSION "ODETTE" HAS MAINTAINED ITS STRENGTH AS IT CONTINUES TO MOVE TOWARDS CAGAYAN-ISABELA AREA.

Location of Eye/Center: (as of 07:00 AM)	655 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan
Coordinates:	17.7°N, 127.9°E
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 65 kph
Movement:	Forecast to move West at 26 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	 24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): In the vicinity of Peñablanca, Cagayan (17.6°N, 122.1°E) 48 Hour (Saturday morning): 280 km West Northwest of Sinait, Ilocos Sur (18.1°N, 117.8°E) 72 Hour (Sunday morning): 725 km West of Sinait, Ilocos Sur (OUTSIDE PAR) (18.4°N, 113.6°E) 96 Hour (Monday morning): 1,180 km West of Sinait, Ilocos Sur (OUTSIDE PAR) (18.6°N, 109.3°E)

TROPICAL CYCLONE WARNING SIGNAL (TCWS)

(30-60 kph expected in 36 hours)

Luzon:

Cagayan including Babuyan group of Islands, Isabela, Apayao, Abra, Kalinga, Mountain Province, Ifugao, **Ilocos Norte and Ilocos Sur**

Wave Height: (Open Sea) 1.25-4.0 meters

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 350 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.
- TD "ODETTE" may intensify into a Tropical Storm before making landfall over Cagayan-Isabela area tomorrow early morning.

Sea travel remains risky over the northern and eastern seaboards of Northern Luzon due to the northeasterly surface windflow enhanced by the approaching Tropical Depression.

The public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council concerned are advised to take appropriate actions and watch for the next weather bulletin to be issued at 11:00 AM today.

You are directed to undertake the necessary preparedness measures and possible response actions. Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
