A. Situation Overview:

- At around 3:00 PM, 15 October 2017, a flash flood incident occurred in Zamboanga City due to heavy rainfalls brought about by the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ). The flooding affected seven (7) barangays in the west coast and two (2) barangays in the east coast of Zamboanga City.

B. Effects:**Affected Population**

- A total of **2,101 families / 8,404 persons** were affected:

Damage

1. A total of **151 houses were damaged (98-partially / 53-totally)** with the following breakdown:

2. **Limapa National High School was partially damaged due to the flooding.**
3. **The sea wall of Barangay Patalon was also partially damaged.**

C. Actions Taken:

- OCD IX is continuously monitoring the situation and in close coordination with Zamboanga DRRMO and DSWD IX for updates.
- OCD IX conducted ocular inspection in Barangays Labuan and Vitali, Zamboanga City.
- DSWD IX is closely coordinating with the concerned Field Office for updates on the status of the affected families and possible assistance needed.
- Regional Disaster Management Center in Pagadian City and Regional Satellite Office in Zamboanga City are manned for 24/7 monitoring, reporting, and dissemination of advisories and updates.
- RDRRMC IX member-agencies are on standby and ready.
- **Labuan BDRRMC provided food packs and non-food items to the evacuees staying inside the Labuan Central School.**
- **Talisayan -BDRRMC distributed Food and Non-Food items to the evacuees staying in Talisayan National High School.**
- **Zamboanga City DRRMO provided hot meals in Barangays Vitali and Mangusu.**
- **Zamboanga City DRRMO distributed slippers in Barangay Labuan.**
