**A. Situation Overview:**

- At around 3:00 PM, 15 October 2017, a flashflood incident was reported Zamboanga due to heavy rainfalls brought about by the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).

**Affected Population**

- A total of **914 families / 3,656 persons** were affected:
