SUBJECT : Severe Weather Bulletin No. 07 re Typhoon "PAOLO" (I.N. "LAN")

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Typhoon "PAOLO" has maintained its strength as it moves north northwestward over the Philippine Sea.

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 1100 km diameter of the typhoon.
- Meanwhile, at 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 150 km Northwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (10.5°N, 117.6°E). This weather system, along with the outer rainbands of "PAOLO" and the southwesterly windflow enhanced by this Typhoon will bring scattered to widespread rains and thunderstorms over Palawan, Bicol region, Visayas, CARAGA, Northern Mindanao, Zamboanga Peninsula and ARMM. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.
- Sea travel remains risky over the seaboard of Northern Luzon, the eastern seaboard of Central and Southern Luzon, the seaboard of Palawan, the western and eastern seaboard of Visayas and the eastern seaboard of Mindanao.
- "PAOLO" is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) by Sunday morning (22 October).

Location of eye/center	At 10:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "PAOLO" was located based on all available data at 945 km East of Infanta, Quezon (15.5 °N, 130.4 °E)
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 120 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 145 kph.
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move North Northwest at 15 kph
