I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Typhoon "PAOLO" has maintained its strength and is about to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 1900 km diameter of the Typhoon.
- "PAOLO" is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) early morning tomorrow.
- The southwesterly wind flow enhanced by this Typhoon will bring cloudy skies with scattered light to moderate and at times heavy rainshowers during thunderstorms over Western Visayas, Mindanao, and Palawan.
- Sea travel remains risky over the seaboard of Northern and Southern Luzon, the eastern seaboard of Central Luzon and of Mindanao, and western and eastern seaboard of Visayas.

Location of eye/center	At 10:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "PAOLO" was located based on all available data at 1,190 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (24.2°N, 132.8°E)
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 185 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 225 kph.
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move North Northeast at 27 kph
Forecast Positions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 1,785 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) (31.2°N, 135.2°E)
