I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- Typhoon "PAOLO" is now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).
- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 1900 km diameter of the Typhoon.
- Cloudy skies with scattered light to moderate and at times heavy rainshowers due to thunderstorms over **Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas and Palawan**.
- Sea travel remains risky over the seaboard of Northern **Luzon**, the eastern seaboard of Central **and Southern Luzon** and **of Visayas**.

Location of eye/center	At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "PAOLO" was located based on all available data at 1,345 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (24.2°N, 132.8°E)
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 185 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 225 kph .
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move North Northeast at 30 kph
Forecast Positions	24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 2,185 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) (34.1°N, 137.9°E)
Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal	No Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal
With this development and unless re-entry, this is the final warning for this weather disturbance
