I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TROPICAL DEPRESSION "RAMIL" HAS MAINTAINED ITS STRENGTH WHILE CROSSING THE OF CALAMIAN GROUP OF ISLANDS.

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy within the 200 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.
- Residents in areas under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) #1 **Central Luzon , Cagayan Valley Region, Northern Quezon** including Polillo island and the rest of Mindoro provinces and of Palawan are alerted against possible landslides and flashfloods. Meanwhile light to moderate with possible occasional heavy rains during thunderstorms will continue to prevail over Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon
- Sea travel remains risky over the areas with TCWS #1, as well as the northern and eastern seaboard of Luzon due to the Tropical Depression and the surge of the Northeast Monsoon.
- "RAMIL" is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility tomorrow evening or Friday early morning.


Location of eye/center	At 7:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "RAMIL" was estimated based on all available data at in the vicinity of Busuanga, Palawan (12.0 °N, 119.9 °E)
Strength	Maximum winds of 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 75 kph
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move West at 18 kph
