### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

**TROPICAL DEPRESSION "RAMIL" HAS MAINTAINED ITS STRENGTH AND IS NOW OVER THE WEST PHILIPPINE SEA.**

- Moderate to occasionally heavy rains are still expected over Mindoro provinces, Palawan, Batangas, Northern Quezon including Polillo Island and Aurora. Residents in these areas alerted against possible landslides and flashfloods. Meanwhile, light to moderate with possible occasional heavy rains during thunderstorms will still prevail over Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon
- Sea travel remains risky over the northern and eastern seaboard of Northern Luzon due to the Tropical Depression and the surge of the Northeast Monsoon.
- Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals elsewhere are now lifted.
- "RAMIL" is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility tonight or tomorrow early morning.

<b>Location of eye/center</b>	At <b>4:00 AM</b> today, the center of <b>Tropical Depression "RAMIL"</b> was estimated based on all available data at <b>230 km West of Coron, Palawan (12.2 °N, 118.1 °E)</b>
<b>Strength</b>	Maximum winds of <b>55 kph</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>65 kph</b>
<b>Forecast Movement</b>	Forecast to move <b>West</b> at <b>15 kph</b>
<b>Forecast Positions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 24 Hour (<b>Tomorrow morning</b>) <b>155 km North Northeast of Pagasa Island, Palawan(12.3°N, 114.6°E)</b></li><li>• 48 Hour (<b>Saturday morning</b>):<b>285 km West Northwest of Pagasa Island, Palawan (OUTSIDE PAR)(12.0°N, 111.7°E)</b></li><li>• 72 Hour (<b>Sunday morning</b>): <b>725 km West of Pagasa Island, Palawan (OUTSIDE PAR)(11.7°N, 107.5°E)</b></li></ul>
