I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

The Philippines is hosting the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) 2017 with the theme "Partnering for Change, Engaging the World" pursuant to Chapter X, Article 31 of the ASEAN Charter coinciding with the Association's 50th Founding Anniversary. The Philippines is one of the founding members of ASEAN and a signatory to the ASEAN Charter which entered into force on 15 December 2008.

The ASEAN is committed to intensifying community building through enhanced regional cooperation and integration, in particular by establishing an ASEAN Community comprising of ASEAN Security Community, the ASEAN Economic Community, and the ASEAN Socio-Cultural Community, as provided for in the Bali Declaration of ASEAN Concord II.

In relation with the Philippines assuming Chairmanship of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) 2017 and the 50th Founding Anniversary of ASEAN on 13-15 November 2017, the Office of the President (OP) issued Administrative Order No. 48, s. 2016 on 04 February 2016 "CREATING THE NATIONAL ORGANIZING COUNCIL FOR THE PHILIPPINES' HOSTING OF THE ASSOCIATION OF SOUTHEAST ASIAN NATIONS (ASEAN) IN 2017, AND PRESCRIBING ITS AUTHORITY AND FUNCTIONS".

The Joint Task Group Emergency Preparedness and Response (JTGEPR) of the NDRRMC through the Office of Civil Defense (OCD), under the Committee on Security, Peace and Order, and Emergency Preparedness and Response (CSPOEPR), is established to oversee the over-all emergency preparedness, response, and consequence management for all natural and human-induced disasters that may occur during the Philippine hosting of the event.

On 02 November 2017, the members of the Joint Task Group Emergency Preparedness and Response (JTGEPR) and the Area Command Team (ACT) established an Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and Incident Command Post (ICP) at the Heritage Hotel, Roxas Blvd., Pasay City.

IV. CURRENT WEATHER SITUATION (as of 4:00 AM, 13 November 2017)

At 3:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) located Southeast of General Santos City has dissipated. Meanwhile, a new Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 90 km North Northeast of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (10.5 N, 119.0 E).

Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to the LPA/Easterlies will be experienced over Eastern Visayas, Zamboanga Peninsula and Palawan. Possible flashfloods and landslides caused by scattered light to moderate with at times heavy rains. Possible lightning and strong winds.

Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to localized thunderstorms will be experienced over Metro Manila and the rest of the country. Possible isolated heavy rains, lightning and strong winds.
