I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The tail-end of a cold front will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains which may trigger flashfloods and landslide over Bicol Region, Visayas, and the Province of Quezon. Furthermore, cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms over MIMAROPA and the Provinces of Cavite, Laguna, Batangas and Rizal.

Meanwhile, at 10:00 AM today, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **420km east of Hinatuan**, **Surigao Del Sur (8.7N, 130.7E)**. This weather system will bring cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms over the regions of CARAGA and Davao. This disturbance may develop into a tropical depression within the next **24-36** hours.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
