## I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The tail-end of a cold front will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains over Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas, and the Province of Quezon. Residents along these areas are alerted for possible landslides and flashfloods.

Meanwhile, at 10:00 AM today, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 775 km east of Davao City, Davao Del Sur (6.8N, 132.8E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms over the regions of CARAGA and Davao. This disturbance may develop into a tropical depression within the next 36-48 hours.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
