Weather Advisory No. 02 for Tail-End of a Cold Front and Low Pressure Area (LPA)

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The tail-end of a cold front will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains **which may trigger flashfloods and landslide** over Bicol Region, **Visayas**, and the Province of Quezon. **Furthermore, cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms over MIMAROPA and the Provinces of Cavite, Laguna, Batangas and Rizal.**

Meanwhile, at 10:00 AM today, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **420km east of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (8.7N, 130.7E)**. This weather system will bring cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms over the regions of CARAGA and Davao. This disturbance may develop into a tropical depression within the next **24-36** hours.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:
