I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Tropical Depression "URDUJA" has slightly changed its course as it continues to move closer to Sorsogon-Northern Samar Area.

Location of eye/center	At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "URDUJA" was estimated based on all available data at 395 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.2°N, 129.3°E)
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 65 kph
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move Northwest at 7 kph
Forecast Positions	 24 Hour (Tomorrow afternoon): 260 km East of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (11.7°N, 127.8°E) 48 Hour (Friday afternoon): 175 km East of Catarman, Northern Samar (12.3°N, 126.2°E) 72 Hour (Saturday afternoon): 130 km West of Southwest Legazpi City, Albay (12.9°N, 122.6°E) 96 Hour (Sunday afternoon): 105 km West of San Jose, Occidental Mindoro (12.3°N, 120.1°E) 120 Hour (Monday afternoon): 135 km Northwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (10.7°N, 118.0°E)

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
