SITUATION OVERVIEW:

"VINTA" HAS SLIGHTLY INTENSIFIED AS IT MOVES WESTWARD OVER THE PHILIPPINE SEA.


- **Scattered to widespread moderate to heavy rains** is expected over Eastern Visayas, CARAGA and Davao Region within 24 hours. Residents of these areas must undertake precautionary measures, coordinate with their respective local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- **Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out** over the eastern seaboard Mindanao due to the moderate to rough seas associated with the approaching Tropical Depression.
- **Expected to make landfall over CARAGA - Davao Region area** between Thursday (December 21) evening and Friday (December 22) morning.
- **Possible inclusion of Dinagat Islands, Camiguin, Misamis Oriental and Bukidnon** in areas under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1 within 6 hours.

Location of eye/center	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "VINTA" was estimated based on all available data 605 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (08.8°N, 131.8°E).
Strength	Maximum winds of up to 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 65 kph.
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move West at 20 kph.
