### SITUATION OVERVIEW:

**"VINTA" HAS MAINTAINED ITS SPEED AND DIRECTION AS IT CONTINUES TO MOVE TOWARD EASTERN MINDANAO.**

- **Scattered to widespread moderate to heavy rains** is expected over Central Visayas, Eastern Visayas, Caraga and Davao Region and Northern Mindanao within 24 hours. Residents of these areas must undertake appropriate actions against possible flooding and landslides, coordinate with their respective local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates.
- **Sea travel is risky** over the seaboard of areas under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS).
- **Expected to make landfall over Caraga - Davao Region area** between **late** this evening and tomorrow morning (22 December).
- **Possible inclusion of Zamboanga del Norte, Zamboanga Sibugay, Southern part of Negros Oriental and of Negros Occidental in areas under TCWS No. 1** in the next bulletin.

<b>Location of eye/center</b>	At <b>10:00 AM</b> today, the center of Tropical Storm "VINTA" was estimated based on all available data <b>340 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.5°N, 129.4°E).</b>
<b>Strength</b>	Maximum sustained winds of up to <b>65 kph</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>80 kph.</b>
<b>Forecast Movement</b>	Forecast to move <b>West at 18 kph.</b>
