AREAS:**

THE EASTERN SEABOARDS OF CENTRAL AND OF SOUTHERN LUZON (Aurora, Camarines Provinces, Catanduanes, eastern coast of Albay, eastern coast of Sorsogon, and eastern coast of Quezon including Polilio Island)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with light rains	(45-63) / (24-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
