NORTHERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, northern coast of Cagayan, including Babuyan Group of Islands, and the northern coast of Ilocos Norte)	Cloudy skies with scattered rains	(45-63) / (24-34)	Rough to Very Rough	2.8 to 4.5
