THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON (Eastern Coast of Quezon Including Polilio Island, Camarines Provinces, Catanduanes, Eastern Coast of Albay, and Eastern Coast of Sorsogon)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	(45-63) / (24-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF MINDANAO (Dinagat Islands, and the eastern coast of Surigao Provinces including Siargao)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	(45-63) / (24-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
