I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM Today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **910 km east of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (9.6N, 134.5E)**. This weather system is expected to develop into a **Tropical Depression** within the next 48 hours. It may **cross Mindanao** beginning Monday (01 January) until Tuesday (02 January) and bring **moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flash flood and landslides**.

Likewise, cloudy skies with occasional to frequent rains is expected over Eastern Visayas caused by the southward migration of the tail-end of cold front.

Should this weather system develop into a Tropical Depression, maritime operations along the eastern seaboard of Mindanao (Surigao, Davao Oriental, Dinagat Islands, and Siargao) and Eastern seaboard of Leyte provinces will be disrupted.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary. **Provide feedback on action taken.**
