### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **385 KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF SURIGAO CITY, SURIGAO DEL NORTE (9.0N, 128.9E)**. This weather system will bring cloudy skies with moderate to heavy rains and thunderstorms over the Bicol Region, Visayas, and Mindanao, particularly in the regions of Eastern Visayas, Caraga, and Davao. Possible development into **TROPICAL DEPRESSION** is expected before landfall over the **CARAGA** area **TONIGHT (01 JANUARY) OR TOMORROW (02 JANUARY)** morning.

Should this weather system develop into a Tropical Depression, maritime operations along the Eastern Seaboard of Mindanao (Surigao, Davao Oriental, Dinagat Islands, and Siargao) and Eastern Seaboard of Leyte provinces will be disrupted as Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1 will be issued.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary. **Provide feedback on action taken.**
