# **NDRRMC UPDATE**

## I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM Today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 910 km east of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (9.6N, 134.5E). This weather system is expected to develop into a Tropical Depression within the next 48 hours. it may cross Mindanao beginning Monday (01 January) until Tuesday (02 January) and bring moderate to heavy rains which may trigger flash flood and landslides.

Likewise, cloudy skies with occasional to frequent rains is expected over Eastern Visayas caused by the southward migration of the tail-end of cold front.

Should this weather system develop into a Tropical Depression, maritime operations along the eastern seaboard of Mindanao (Surigao, Davao Oriental, Dinagat Islands, and Siargao) and Eastern seaboard of Leyte provinces will be distrupted.

## II. ACTIONS TAKEN:
