





I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated based on all available data at **385 KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF SURIGAO CITY, SURIGAO DEL NORTE (9.0N, 128.9E)**. This weather system will bring cloudy skies with moderate to heavy rains and thunderstorms over the Bicol Region, Visayas, and Mindanao, particularly in the regions of Eastern Visayas, Caraga, and Davao. Possible development into **TROPICAL DEPRESSION** is expected before landfall over the **CARAGA** area **TONIGHT (01 JANUARY) OR TOMORROW (02 JANUARY)** morning.

Should this weather system develop into a Tropical Depression, maritime operations along the Eastern Seaboard of Mindanao (Surigao, Davao Oriental, Dinagat Islands, and Siargao) and Eastern Seaboard of Leyte provinces will be disrupted as Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1 will be issued.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 02 for the Low Pressure Area (LPA)** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
