I. EFFECTS OF TAIL-END OF A COLD FRONT (REGION V and IX)

A. Situation Overview:

- Tail-End of a Cold Front affecting the eastern section of Southern Luzon and of Visayas. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
- Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers will be experienced over MIMAROPA and Mindanao caused by Localized thunderstorms. Possible flash floods or landslides due to isolated light to moderate to at times heavy rains.

C. Actions Taken:

- OCD V in coordination with PDRRMCs and PAGASA re current weather situation and Status and Effects of the Tail-End Cold Front;
- OCD V disseminated Weather Advisories thru Smart Info-Board, SMS Text Blast, and Facebook.
- PDRRMO Camarines Sur disseminated advisories to the public via SMS and Facebook.
- PDRRMO Camarines Sur coordinated with PDRRMO of Camarines Norte for possible diversion of traffic from Andaya Highway to Maharlika Highway (via Sta. Elena)
- PDRRMO Camarines Sur, Camarines Norte, Catanduanes, Albay, Masbate and Sorsogon is continuously monitoring the situation in their respective AOR and disseminated weather advisories to the public via SMS and Facebook Page.
- MDRRMO Roxas conducted Damage Assessment and immediate relief operations at Barangay Langatian, Galokso and Piao.
- MDRRMO Roxas conducted relief operations at Brgy. Dohinob, Piñalan and Situbo.
- OCD IX is continuously monitoring the situation and constantly coordinating with the PDRRMO and LDRRMOs of Zamboanga del Norte.
- MSWDO Manukan distributed food items to affected barangays initially to Lupasang and Saluyong.
- PDRRMO Zamboanga del Norte conducts SRR to the affected areas in the municipality of Roxas.
- Dec. 26, 2017, LGU-Katipunan conducted relief operations to affected barangays
- Dec. 27, 2017, LGU-Roxas MDRRMO, Zamboanga Del Norte conducted damaged assessment and immediate relief operations at Barangay Langatian, Galokso and Piao while on Dec. 28, 2017 in Barangay Dahinob, Piñalan and Situbo.
- BFP, PNP, LDRRM Office, Barangay Officials/ Tanod of Manukan, Zamboanga Del Norte continuously monitoring the situation in their respective areas.

II. Drowning Incident at Brgy. Quillat, Lagiden, Abra

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 3:00 PM, 28 December 2017, a drowning incident happened along Abra River, Brgy. Quillat, Langiden, Abra
- Based on the initial investigation conducted by Langiden MPS, Isidro Aglibot Bueno, son of Lagiden Vice Mayor together with his four (4) companions went to river to swim at 2:00PM, while swimming, they were suddenly taken by strong current causing them to drown.
- Faye Bueno Millare, Clarefe Bueno Millare were immediately saved while Isidro Aglibot Bueno and Pricess Bueno Millare were rushed to Seares Memorial Hospital, but they were pronounced Dead On Arrival by the attending physician.

- On 29 December 2017 at 6:00AM, the cadaver of Sheeny Bersola was retrieved along Abra River, Brgy. Quillat, Langiden, Abra by three fishermen namely Florentino Britanico and Manny Molina. The cadaver was brought at Pineda Homes, Bangued, Abra
