### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

The Trough of a Low Pressure Area (LPA) will bring moderate to heavy rains over Palawan, the whole of Visayas, and CARAGA while light to moderate rains will prevail over northern Mindanao. the Tail-end of a Cold Front will bring light to moderate rains over the provinces of Albay, Sorsogon, Masbate, and Romblon. Residents in these areas must undertake precautionary measures against possible flash floods and landslides and coordinate with their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction And Management Offices.

The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-hour public weather forecast at 4:00 PM today and the next advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow when necessary.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
