I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Tail-End of a Cold Front will bring moderate to heavy rains over the provinces of Masbate, Albay and Sorsogon. Meanwhile, the trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA) will also bring moderate to heavy rains over **Palawan** and the Regions of **Eastern Visayas, Central Visayas, Davao and CARAGA**. Residents in these areas must undertake precautionary measures against possible flash floods and landslides and coordinate with their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices.

The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-hour public weather forecast at 4:00 PM today and the next advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow when necessary.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
