### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

The **Tail-end of a Cold Front** will bring moderate to heavy rains over **Aurora, Quezon, and Bicol region** while light to moderate rains will prevail over the rest of **Central Luzon and Calabarzon, Metro Manila, and the provinces of Isabela, Quirino, Nueva Vizcaya, Pangasinan, Marinduque, Romblon, and Mindoro**. The **Trough of a Low Pressure Area (LPA)** will bring light to moderate rains over **Eastern Visayas and CARAGA**. Residents in these areas must undertake precautionary measures against **possible flash floods and landslides** and coordinate with their respective local disaster risk reduction and management offices.

The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-hour public weather forecast at 4:00 PM today and the next advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow when necessary.


You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
