I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Tail-end of a Cold Front is no longer affecting any part of the country. However, the Provinces of Aurora and Quezon, and the Regions of CARAGA and DAVAO will continue to have cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms due to the easterlies.

With this development, this is the final advisory for this weather system.
