#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

The **Tail-end of a Cold Front** will bring moderate to heavy rains over **Aurora, Quezon, and Bicol region** while light to moderate rains will prevail over **the rest of Central Luzon and Calabarzon, Metro Manila, and the provinces of Isabela, Quirino, Nueva Vizcaya, Pangasinan, Marinduque, Romblon, and Mindoro**. The **Trough of a Low Pressure Area (LPA)** will bring light to moderate rains over **Eastern Visayas and CARAGA**. Residents in these areas must undertake precautionary measures against **possible flash floods and landslides** and coordinate with their respective local disaster risk reduction and management offices.

The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-hour public weather forecast at 4:00 PM today and the next advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow when necessary.
