I. Initial Report re Fire Incident at No. 8 k7 Street, Kamuning, Quezon City Source: OCDRO NCR

A. Situation Overview

 At around 30 1310H January, a fire incident occurred at a Residential house with the address, No. 8 k7 Street, Kamuning, Quezon City, owned by Romeo San Juan. Cause of fire is still under investigation.

B. Effects

 - Adelino Sanggalang, 53 y/o, multiple abrasion

 - Ricky Labasog, 31 y/o, 1st degree burn, right shoulder
- Evacuation Area
 - There is no evacuation area as of this report.
- Families Affected
 - 30 families were affected
- Houses Affected
 - 10 houses were affected

II. Initial Report re Vehicular Incident at KM 57, Calasipan, Cattubo, Atok, Benguet

A. Situation Overview

- A van bound for Baguio City driven by Rey Carias Batong with eight (8) passengers fell on a ravine of more or less 300 meters deep resulting to six (6) injured passengers and three (3) deaths (driver and two (2) passengers).
- Interview to the residents averred that they saw the vehicle overtook an elf truck then suddenly fell at the ravine.
- Victims were brought firstly to Atok District Hospitals for treatment before they were referred/ transferred to different hospitals in La Trinidad and Baguio City.
- Rescue and retrieval operations ended at about 5:45 PM on the same day of incident.
- Involved vehicles: HIACE Van PN AEN 382
- Date and Time of Incident: 1:50 PM, January 30, 2018 at KM 57, Calasipan, Cattubo, Atok, Benguet
