**I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

At **06:00 PM**, the **Low Pressure Area** (formerly Tropical Depression "Basyang") was estimated based on all available data at **155 km South Southeast of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (8.4N, 118.4E)**. Latest analysis indicates that **significant re-development** of this weather disturbance into a Tropical Depression is **still likely**.

The Low Pressure Area will bring **occasionally gusty winds and scattered light to moderate with at times heavy rains** over Palawan, becoming **widespread moderate to heavy rains over its southern section**. Residents in these areas are advised to continue monitoring for updates, take appropriate measures against possible **flooding and landslides**, and coordinate with their respective local disaster risk reduction and management offices.

**Sea travel remains risky** over the seaboard of Palawan due to rough to very rough seas associated with the interaction between this disturbance and the Northeast Monsoon.

**II. ACTIONS TAKEN:**

NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 01** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
